Amman Forum on Measuring, Monitoring and Assessing PVE *Preventing Violent Extremism: Understanding Recruitment // Evidencing Impact* 18-19 June 2019 - Amman, Jordan

PVE is a maturing field of development and recent years have seen a substantial increase in both research and programming on for PVE, but whilst a community of practice on prevention is forming, more efforts should be made to create opportunities for interdisciplinary exchange - to share new data, research and lessons from the field on what works in preventing violent extremism. Through the Amman Forum, UNDP aims to bring research and M&E decidedly to the forefront of discussions by creating such an opportunity for experts, academics and practitioners to share evidence, experiences and learning.
